**STATEMENT OF ROBERT L. CORBIN FOLLOWING GRAIG GUNTHER'S
GUILTY PLEA TO TWO MISDEMEANOR VIOLATIONS RELATING TO
REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE CODE OF FEDERAL
REGULATIONS**

Mr. Gunther is the former COO for the Family Office of Dr. Henry T. Nicholas, III, who is the co-founder of Broadcom. During its investigation of Broadcom, the government learned that Dr. Nicholas frequently directed the Family Office to withdraw large sums of cash from his personal bank account and deliver it to him or to his designated representative.

When the FO's controller did not go to the bank personally, she broke large check requests into smaller amounts to keep the identity of couriers confidential, address security concerns, monitor Dr. Nicholas' employees and avoid the completion of paperwork at the bank which identified the couriers. Mr. Gunther knew about this practice and signed most of the checks. Neither Mr. Gunther nor anyone else at the FO knew that the practice was illegal. All funds came from a single bank account, were lawfully obtained and fully accounted for on the FO's books. The bank never told Mr. Gunther that this practice was against the law. Nevertheless, the government has elected to charge Mr. Gunther with a crime known as "structuring".

We believe that the government's decision to resolve these regulatory matters as misdemeanors is consistent with the fact that Mr. Gunther was unaware that structuring had been criminalized, handled all monies in accord with his fiduciary obligations and was motivated by privacy, security and accountability concerns.
